# Budapest Noir: Ilona Gets A Phone Set for U.S. Release in May 2025

October 2024 – London, UK – Following its successful European release in April 2024, Alison Langley's debut novel, *Budapest Noir: Ilona Gets A Phone*, will be launched in the U.S. on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Published by Dedalus Books UK, the novel offers an insightful look at post-Communist Hungary through the deeply personal struggles of a woman navigating both geopolitical change and family dynamics.

Set in 1991, *Budapest Noir* follows Ilona, a 61-year-old Hungarian woman who receives a

telephone after years of being denied due to her family's political history under Soviet rule. For Ilona, the phone represents a personal victory, yet it also highlights the limitations of her life. As Hungary transitions from socialism to democracy, Ilona devises a plan to reclaim her family's estate—confiscated by the communists—by relying on her American son, Emil. However, Emil's return to Hungary reveals unexpected tensions as he pursues an artistic career rather than the business success Ilona hopes for.
